## Other Rules/Guidelines:

#### The Draw:

As seeding would not be possible, due to no Carebaco tournaments having been held recently.

The top 2 players from each country will be separated in the draw of each event. One in the top half and the other in the bottom half of the draw.

Where possible, players from the same country will not meet in the 1<sup>st</sup> round.

The draw will be carried out at the end of the Team Managers Meeting. The draw will be supervised and approved by the Referee before publication.

A maximum of 2 (two) rounds per event, per day is allowed in the main draw.

#### **Substitutions:**

Countries may apply to the Referee no later than the start of the Team Manager's Meeting for substitutions. Only players already registered by close of entries will be allowed as substitutes.

Proof of age will be required before substitutions will be allowed. The Referee will announce all substitutions at the Team Managers meeting.

#### **Coaches:**

All coaches on the Field of play will be required to have their Accreditation on their person.

Coaches have to be properly attired. Jeans, hats, and flip flops will not be allowed as part of attire. Tee Shirt with sleeves, track pants will be allowed.

Coaches will not be allowed to have in their hands any form of electronic device.









#### Accreditation:

Less than 3 players: 1 Badge

Four to Seven players: 2 Badges

Eight to 15 Players: 3 Badges

Over 16 Players: 4 Badges

#### **Rest Time:**

The rest time between two matches will be 30 minutes.

### **Prize Ceremony:**

All players will be properly attired for the prize ceremony. Playing uniforms or track suits will be allowed.

All players will be required to wear sneakers on the rostrum. Slippers/open slippers will not be allowed.

Flags, banners, racquets, towels etc. will not be allowed. The Referee will have the final decision.
