Events:

Players will be allowed a maximum of three (3) events. Players may enter two (2) events in their age group and <u>one event at the next higher age group</u>, subject to TTBA tournament and ranking rules. Entries outside of this rule will automatically be rejected and no new entry will be allowed. i.e. if a player is entered in BS U15, BD U15 and BS U19. The BSU19 will automatically be rejected.

Consolation Draw

Subject to playing time constraints, consolation draw for Singles events will be added. Consolation draw will be added in reverse order BU19, GU19, BU17, GU17, BU15 etc. Singles events will be considered for the consolation draw.

Rest Time:

The maximum rest time to be applied between matches will be 30 minutes. Matches can be called up to 1 hour before the time stated on the schedule.

Scheduling:

Time off requests during this tournament may not be possible due to the time constraints of the tournament.

Seeding:

Seeding will be based on ranking points up to 01 January 2019.

No of Seeds to be applied:

1 to 8 entries2 seeds9 to 16 entries4 seeds17 to 32 entries8 seeds

Ranking points to be awarded – Nationals as indicated below.

Coach Protocols:

- Coaches are to be properly attired. Jeans, hats, and flip flops will not be allowed as part of attire. Tee Shirt with sleeves, track pants will be allowed.
- Players entered in this tournament are not allowed to coach other players.
- All Coaches must wear a TTBA provided Coach ID Badge. These badges will be issued to TTBA Accredited Coaches. TTBA Level 1/2/3 or BWF Coach Level 1 to 2.
- Each badge will be issued at a cost of \$10.00. On return of the badge, the cost will be refunded.
- Badges will be issued to individual coaches and the badges are non transferable. Coaches will lose their accreditation for breach of use or use by other persons.
- Badges must be fully displayed and visible to Umpires.
- The Coach ID badge will not be useable in future tournaments.

Agreement:

Any member club or other organisation who has entered a player into this tournament, agrees to abide with the rules and regulations governing this tournament.

The member club or other organisation further agrees to ensure that all players are fully aware of all the rules and regulations governing this tournament. Players must comply with all rules and regulations of this tournament.
